- Application letter addressed to the Director General of HEC
- National ID/Valid Passeport
- Curriculum Vitae
- One (1) passport size photo
- Original-notified certificate and transcripts
- Recommendation letter from two current or former academic staff who taught or supervised the applicant
- A study plan or research proposal (Minimum of 500 words)
- Applicants should be under 35 years old for Masters and 40 years old for PhD as of 01/April/2023
- English skills both in written and oral communication to complete Master's and/or Ph.D. courses with skills equivalent or exceeding the following: TOEFL iBT: 80, IELTS: 6.5, CEFR B2

2. The scholarships cover all costs of study including tuition fees, accommodation, living allowances, medical insurance. Any other extra luggage expenses that may arise will be covered by the student.
