- Indicate delivery timelines and warranty details (if applicable).

Bidders are requested to submit the following documents in their tender offers:

- Company profile and relevant experience
- Detailed financial quotation (including unit and total prices, VAT inclusive)
- Delivery schedule and payment terms
- References from at least two previous clients.

4. Submission deadline
